 - Each player will follow rules & philosophy of Apple Valley High School Baseball & MSHSL

Composition of Teams

- Junior Varsity (2 coaches & 13-15 players)
- Main focus is getting players ready for the varsity level
- Focus will be putting together a competitive lineup for each game
- Continued emphasis on player development through accelerated practices with varsity
 - Players at this level should be focused on playing specific positions

Composition of Teams 10th (2 coaches & 13-16 players)

- Main focus is on continued player development through repetition and game involvement
 - Encourage athletes to get out of their comfort zone for maximum exposure
 - Equal playing time is still encouraged
- Start looking for players who are ready for the JV or possible Varsity level
